Notice is hereby given, that Independent School District No. 139, Rush City, Minnesota, will receive quotes for the supplying of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel for the operation of school vehicles for the period from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, according to the specifications and conditions which may be obtained from our website at [www.rushcity.k12.mn.us](http://www.rushcity.k12.mn.us) under District – School Board – Bids/Quotes, or by contacting the office of the Superintendent at PO Box 566, 51001 Fairfield Avenue, Rush City, Minnesota, 55069. Quotes shall be submitted in form and manner contained in the specifications and the conditions, which are adopted by reference, in this invitation for quotes. Quotes must be received in the office of the Superintendent of Schools at the above listed address or via email to [nsorgert@rushcity.k12.mn.us](mailto:nsorgert@rushcity.k12.mn.us), no later than May 9, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. at which time the quotes will be reviewed. On Thursday, May 19th at 5:30 pm, the School Board will meet to evaluate the quotes and act thereon.

Quotes for unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel supply should be at a location within two miles of the District Office. Providers must explain hours of service and availability outside the hours of service. Quote prices per gallon of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel as of **May 4, 2022 excluding all tax**. Provider assumes all liability costs for tanks.

The school district reserves the right to accept, reject, or waive any informality of any quote and to make an award for fuel which is deemed most favorable and advantageous to the school district.
